





- The University of Dodoma (UDOM) was established in 2007; Dodoma City is located in the centre of the country (6°10'23''S; 35°44'31''E), 455 km west of Dar es Salaam,
- The University campus is approximately 8 kilometres East of Dodoma city centre, covering 6,000 hectares



When you are in Dodoma city, whether during the day or night, you will be able to see some of the buildings of the University of Dodoma including the famous Chimwaga conference hall.






UDOM is the largest university in the country and aims at enrolling 40,000 students at a time when its infrastructure will be completed.

In the academic year 2023/2024, the number of students enrolled on different programmes is 30,872 for undergraduate and diploma studies, and for postgraduate programmes (masters, PhD, and postgraduate diploma) is 836.

• The University of Dodoma has been attracting many students from East and Central African Countries in different disciplines.

• In all cases, the University ensures that its entire curricula are approved by the **Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU)** for implementation as per norms.







