INTRODUCTION

The Félix Houphouët-Boigny University (UFHB) is the largest university in Côte d'Ivoire in terms of surface area and administrative and teaching staff. UFHB is Côte d'Ivoire's main teaching and research centre. Located in Abidjan, the country's economic capital, the UFHB grew out of the three university centres attached to the National University of Côte d'Ivoire (1971), whose origins date back to the creation of the Abidjan Higher Education Centre in 1958 and which was elevated to university status by presidential decree on 9 January 1964. The Félix Houphouët-Boigny University, which is multidisciplinary in nature, consists of 13 training and research units (UFR); 2 autonomous research centres; 1 School of continuing education; 14 research institutes and centres, 31 laboratories and 4 doctoral schools. In terms of staff, the figures for the Félix Houphouët-Boigny University are as follows: 3,311 people, of which 2,510 are professors and 801 administrative and technical staff (PAT), and 56,776 students in 2022-2023. These figures make it the most important ecosystem in the education and training sector in Côte d'Ivoire.

- Implementing and enforcing the terms of agreements and conventions;

1.2. Cooperation Service

1.2.2. The missions of the International Relations Office /BI in charge of:

- Listing and centralising all international programme agreements and offers (Africa Zone, Europe Zone, America Zone, Asia and Oceania Zone, Erasmus+ and non-Erasmus+ programmes, Volunteering, etc.);
- Disseminating the scholarship offers of international programmes (Africa Zone, Europe Zone, America Zone, Europe Zone, Erasmus+ and non-Erasmus+ programmes, etc.);
- Managing outgoing and incoming mobilities;
- Seeking, promoting and strengthening university partnerships;

The Internship and Professional Insertion Service is in charge of:

- Developing relations with the business world
- seek and develop internships in companies;
- Facilitating the professional integration of graduates ;
- Creating an observatory for professional insertion
- overseeing and managing relations with companies.

OUR VISION AND POLICY ON INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND COOPERATION

The shared vision of the FHB University is that of a high-performing, innovative, civic university that is open to the outside world. Openness to the outside world is essential, because no university can live in isolation. A university must open up to the outside world to make itself known, share its expertise, improve its image and promote a competitive educational and research offer.

This openness to the outside world is reflected in the signing of agreements, the monitoring and evaluation of the different agreements, the implementation of international projects and the outgoing and incoming Mobilities. Hence, the very important role of Spanish Universities and Institutions in the framework of mobilities.

In 2024: 20 outgoing mobilities to Spain (Erasmus programme for teachers and administrative and service staff)

In 2023: 20 outgoing mobilities to Spain (Erasmus programme for teachers and administrative and service staff).

2022: 44 outgoing mobility to Spain (Erasmus programme for teachers and administrative and service staff).

Mobility, especially through contact with Spain, is a real tool for internationalisation in Côte d'Ivoire, and specifically at the Félix Houphouët-Boigny University, through the aforementioned results. Through common, specific and shared themes, the LIDERAFRICA Programme will favour the training of university staff and reinforce both the capacities and the visibility and influence of the UFHB, the first university institution in Ivory Coast. Beyond the UFHB, this consortium will allow us to face new challenges by positively impacting our African societies open to the European world.
