ANNEX III – Procedure of Admission of the nominated students

University of Cádiz

Deadline for nominations: 30th April 2026

Once the nomination period has closed, the Evaluation Commission of the Vice-rectorate for Internationalisation will study all the submitted documents and will send a registration link to each nominated student. The receipt of a registration link does not imply in any case the admission of the student, only the approval of the process of nomination.

The nominated students must fill an application in the ORIUCA platform from the Universidad de Cádiz and will provided the following documentation:

1. Language Certificate of the language of teaching at the UCA (Spanish, English, French at level B1 or higher).
2. Copy of passport which will be used for the travel to Spain. The passport must be valid at least until September 2027 in order to be able to process the corresponding visa.

If at the time of the application the student does not have a valid passport or if the expiry date is before September 2027, he/she must attach the passport he/she has at that time on a provisional basis, and provide the new one by e-mail before July, 1 2026.

Deadline for filling the application and attaching all the documentation: 07/05/2026

From the moment that the student has been nominated, the student also needs to issue the following documents with the UCA and send them by e-mail to Erasmus.ka107.incoming@gm.uca.es:

1. Learning Agreement signed by the three parties: the student, the academic coordinator of the Home University and the academic coordinator of the UCA (**Annex VI**). The contact information of the international mobility coordinators

Deadline for sending the Learning Agreement and the Research Plan (if needed): 01/06/2026

University of Huelva

Deadline for nominations: 10/05/2026

Once the nomination period has closed, and the Evaluation Commission of the UHU has studied all the documentation, the selected students will receive an email asking for a copy of their passports which will also include, among other information, a link for their online registration, as well as an UMove mobility platform manual. All the mobility and the documentation associated with it will be managed through this platform.

After the passports are received, the students will be sent their acceptance letter/approval needed for the application of their visa.

The students will have to fill out the Online Registration Form in order to obtain their credentials (username and password), needed for all the UHU digital recourses (Moodle, WiFi, email, etc). The deadline for this registration will be 01/07/2026.

Using those same credentials, the students will registrar in the mobility platform UMove. Accessing their “Mi plaza”, the students must fill out:

1. Academic information
2. Information about their stay
3. Learning Agreement, following the UMove Manual. The deadline for adding this information will be 13/09/2026.

After filling out this information, the acceptance letters (student cards) will be sent to the Vicerectorate of International Alliances for their signing. Once signed, the students will receive them in approximately 1 week.





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University of La Laguna

Deadline for nominations: 10/05/2026

Once the nomination period has closed, the Evaluation Commission of the Vicerectorate of Internacionalisation and Cooperation will study all the received documentation and send the nominated students the steps for filling out the admission process. The receipt of a registration link does not imply in any case the admission of the student, only the approval of the process of nomination.

The nominated students must fill out the “Solicitud de Admisión” form, enabled by the ULL, and attach the following documentation:

1. Language Certificate (Spanish, English, French at level B1 or higher).
2. Copy of passport which will be used for the travel to Spain. The passport must be valid at least until September 2027 in order to be able to process the corresponding visa.

If at the time of the application the student does not have a valid passport or if the expiry date is before September 2027, he/she must attach the passport he/she has at that time on a provisional basis, and provide the new one by e-mail before July, 1 2026.
