ANEXO VII –Erasmus+ KA171 SMS IN Financial aid
(Funding information and rules)

1. Types of grants for an Erasmus+ KA171 SMS IN stay

Zero grant (*beca cero*)¹: the beneficiary students will be exempted from tuition fees and will be able to use the host university facilities without additional costs (excluding services whose fees are also applicable to the host university students) **but they will NOT receive an Erasmus+ funded grant**, having to assume the traveling and expenses costs.

Full grant: the beneficiary students will be exempted from tuition fees and will be able to use the host university facilities without additional costs (excluding services whose fees are also applicable to the host university students). **Moreover, they will receive an Erasmus+ funded grant for traveling and expenses** (see amounts and requirements in the following section).

2. Full grant amounts and requirements

Grants for long-term physical mobility of students from countries not associated to the Programme coming to Spain (Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación - SEPIE)

As a general rule, selected students with full grant will receive the individual ordinary grant (IA), as well as the grant for travel costs (II).

Those students who meet the requirements established by the Agencia Nacional Erasmus+ de España (SEPIE) to be considered as students with **fewer opportunities** and submit the respective supporting documentation in Spanish or English in the moment of the pre-selection in its Home University, may benefit, in addition to the individual ordinary grant (IA) and the grant for travel costs (II), from the **additional support to the**

The students coming from disadvantaged environments cannot be beneficiaries of the zero grant (Ukrainian students, for example.)

individual grant for students with fewer opportunities (IB), provided that the evaluation of the supporting documentation of the student submitted by the home institution is satisfactory by the UCA.

Meanwhile, those students with a **recognised disability of 33%** or other physical, mental or other issues related to their health duly documented which need **additional economical support** to the individual grant could apply for information on the **complementary support** that can be received in case their mobility application is accepted (III).

I. Individual grant

Monthly support paid based on the actual days of physical stay in the host university to carry out the academic activities reflected in the Learning Agreement,

A. Individual grant: 850€ per month

B. Additional support to the individual grant for students with fewer opportunities²: 250€ per month

II. Grant for travel costs

Single aid according to the actual distance in kilometers between the home institution and the host institution calculated with the following distance calculator:

III. Special support for people with disabilities

Those students who have a recognised disability equal or superior to 33% or other health

² For the participants to benefit from this grant, they must submit to the host university the documentation justifying at least one of the profiles indicated in the [Strategy of Inclusion and diversity of the SEPIE \(16/12/2022\)](#) The grant is not accumulative if the participant submits more than one condition. If the language of the documentation is different from Spanish or English, they must submit a sworn translation.
