Strong Points

- 1. Support for International Students: the project includes robust support for international students through the Welcome Center, assisting with visa processing and accommodation. This allows students to focus on their studies without being burdened by logistical issues.
- 2. Transparent and Equitable Selection Process: the selection process for participants is transparent and equitable, developed jointly by all consortium institutions, ensuring fairness and inclusivity.
- 3. Strategic Alignment with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs): the consortium's strategy aligns well with the SDGs and the internationalization strategies of the participating universities, focusing on capacity building for leaders in Southern Europe and Africa.













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Strong Points

- 4. **Geographic and Historical Relevance**: Spanish institutions leverage their geographic and historical connections with Africa, strengthening cultural and academic exchanges.
- 5. **Consortium's Experience**: the experience of the Spanish Universities in Erasmus programs reinforces the consortium's capacity to achieve its strategic objectives.
- 6. Comprehensive Impact and Dissemination Strategy: the proposal outlines a rigorous strategy for evaluating and disseminating the project's impact through publications, conferences, and media, enhancing visibility and fostering future collaborations.













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Areas for Improvement

- 1. Intercultural Challenges and Conflict Management: there is a need to better address intercultural challenges and conflict management, which are crucial for the adaptation of students in international environments. Implementing intercultural training programs for students and staff would be beneficial.
- 2. **Detailed Evaluation Methodology**: the current evaluation system, although comprehensive, could be improved with a more detailed methodology to measure the real impact on program improvement. This includes establishing a more structured feedback mechanism to proactively address issues.













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Areas for Improvement

- 3. **Impact Measurement and Strategic Adjustment**: the proposal lacks details on how the impact of activities will be measured and how strategies will be adjusted based on results. Implementing a continuous evaluation and monitoring system to measure the impact relative to the SDGs and adjusting strategies accordingly is recommended.
- 4. **Proactive Adjustments and Community Engagement**: while the dissemination strategy is robust, it would benefit from more detailed methods of evaluation that allow for proactive adjustments. Increasing community engagement and participation activities would make the consortium's impact more tangible and relevant to target populations.


